The Swiss syllabus allows students to choose majors and electives subjects fully. Our school offers internships abroad and conducts extracurricular studies for students of different grades in famous European cities like Munich in Germany and Rome in Italy. Students of the 11th Grade attend English training in the United Kingdom, such as Oxford University.

University Acceptance

Gymnasium & Internat Kloster Disentis (GKD) has a university progression rate of 98%. According to intramural statistics, our students choose to study undergraduates in medical schools and schools of economics, and the universities selected as ETH Zurich, Ecole Supérieure de Lausanne, University of St. Gallen, University of Bern and other well-known Swiss universities. In terms of university tuition policy, international students are the same as Swiss native students, and the university tuition fee is about 900 Swiss francs per semester.

Exemption of University Exam

Graduates of Swiss Matura enjoy Switzerland's policy of exempting entrance exams from local universities, including ETH Zurich, the 6th best institution globally. This policy is not eligible for medical school applications.

7. Admissions target

Age requirement

Students between 13 and 14-year-old from the 8th or 9th grade

Academic Requirements

Students must come from a school of the same level as Gymnasium & Internat Kloster Disentis (GKD) and achieve excellent grades at their current school. Students' average scores cannot be less than 85 points, and their grades in a single subject cannot be less than 80 points.

Language Requirements

Students must pass the German Intermediate Elementary (B1) examination and obtain a German B1 certificate issued by the Goethe Institut or other internationally recognized language institutions.

8. Application Period

On or before 30 June 2022.

9. Application Method

The partner school or organisations of Gymnasium & Internat Kloster Disentis (GKD) support the application process. The application conducts two interviews.

The first round of interviews is conducted at the partner schools or organizations in China. The second round of interviews is completed at the Gymnasium & Internat Kloster Disentis in Switzerland, and parents of students must be present.

10. Registration Process

Students must complete the " Admission Registration Form of Gymnasium & Internat Kloster Disentis" and provide a school report of the last two semesters, passport copy,
